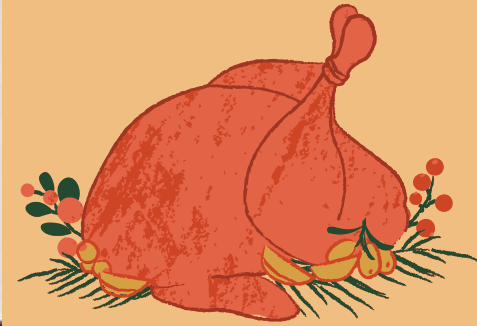

The Birds of English Turn

As promised, we are back with the second article from resident Jennifer Alexander, about the birds that frequent our neighborhood and her garden. We hope you enjoyed the previous article, on Native Trees, and are thrilled to have your attention once again.

"We moved into The Villas in November of 2019. In the spring of 2020, we did a landscaping overhaul with a focus on adding native trees, shrubs, and flowering plants to our yard. I am happy to report that since we have been living here we have seen over **85 species of birds in our yard.**

Just this morning, I had coffee on our patio while watching 5 hummingbirds zip around with excitement. There were 3 **Ruby-throated (1)** and 2 **Rufous/Allen's (2)**, which you can see pictured below. I believe the Ruby-throated was an immature or female hummingbird due to the fact that it does not have a full ruby throat. That photo was taken from my kitchen window—not the best pic but hey, it's hard to take photos when you are washing dishes!

Last week I witnessed a **Bald Eagle (3)** soar into our pine tree and was able to take a pic with my iPhone from my living room. We also often see **Carolina Chickadees (4)**, **Ruby-crowned Kinglets (5)**, **Cedar Waxwings (6)**, and **Yellow-throated Warblers (7)** flying around our garden."

Toll Tag Reactivation

Recently, we have had several residents call the office to report that their tags do not work anymore. Upon investigating, we found that those tags had expired.

Architecture Standards Committee: Applications Now Open

The Board of Directors is now accepting applications to become a member of the ASC. All that is required is that you are a member of the POA in good standing (current on your dues and free from any litigation or fines associated with your property) and have a background in, or knowledge of, construction, architecture, engineering, design, or gardening. You may also qualify if you would simply like to assist in preserving the aesthetic of the neighborhood.



The time commitment for ASC members is generally 1-2 hours per week on Wednesday mornings. Meetings are held in the lobby of the POA building. Committee members review submissions which include, but are not limited to, new construction; changes to the exterior of existing structures; and landscape plans.

The ASC membership appointment is for one calendar year beginning in January. Once applications are received, the Board of Directors will designate a nominating committee to choose the members for the upcoming year. The term of service is one calendar year, beginning **January 1, 2022**.
